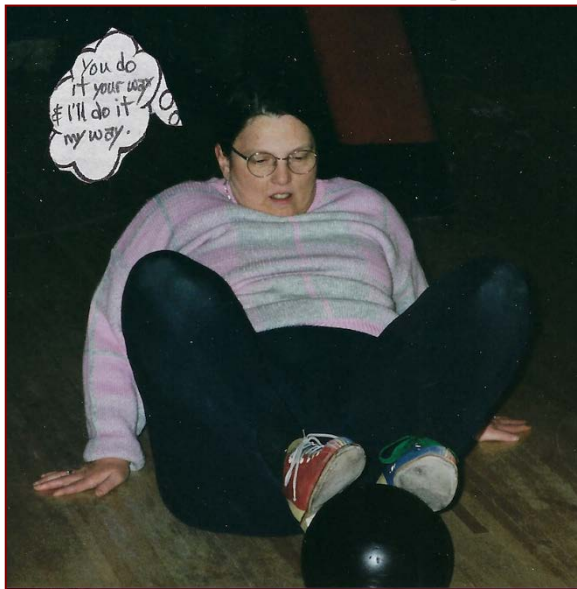

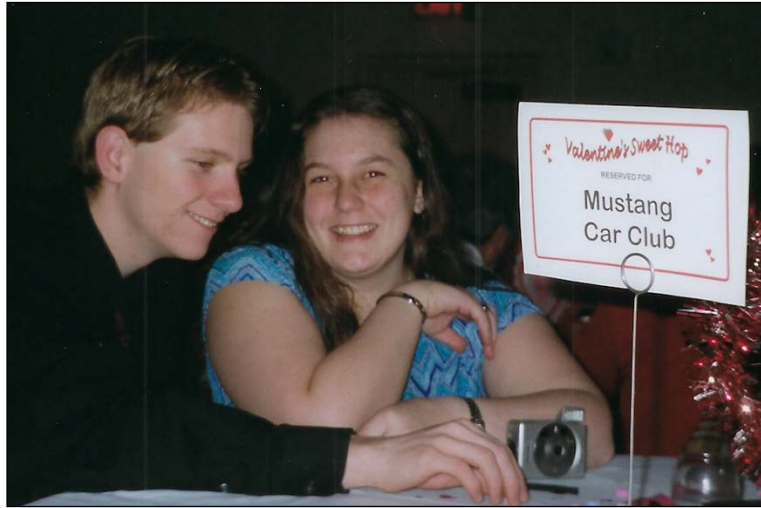

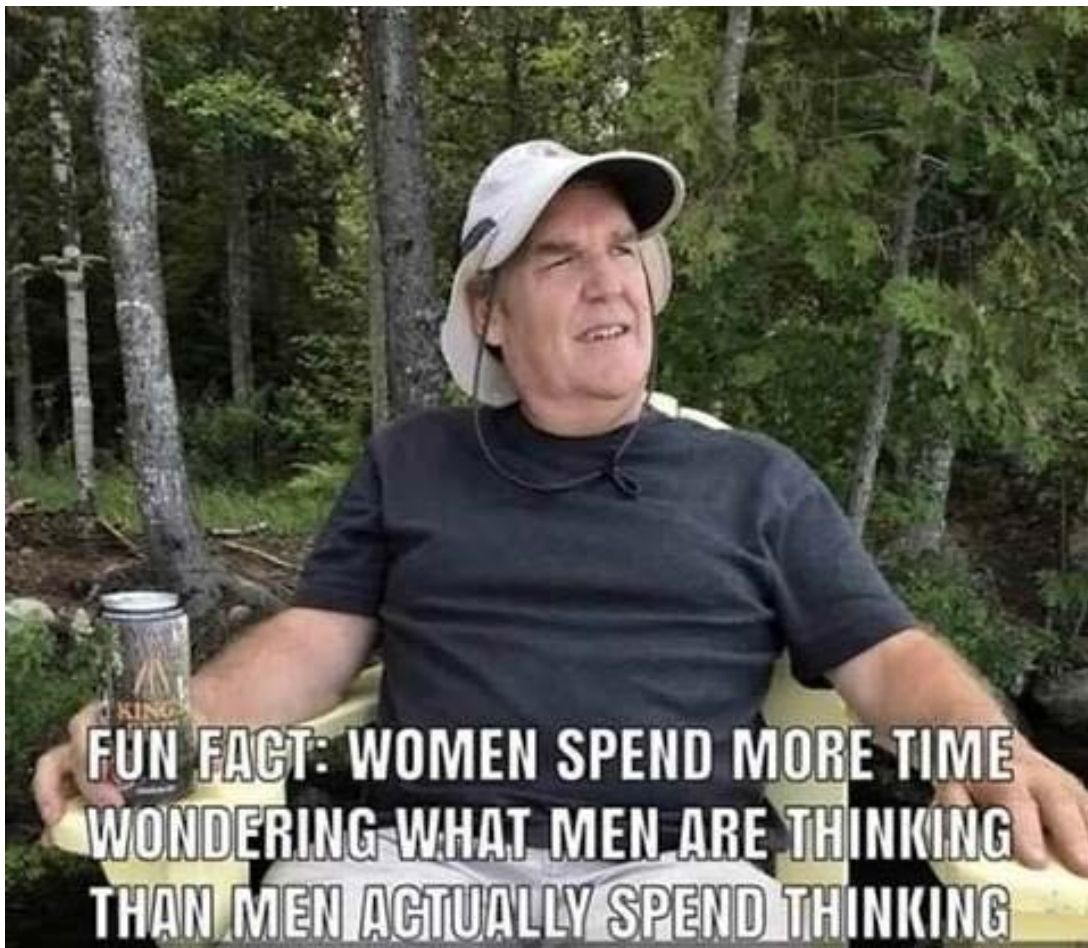
Email received a few days ago:
